ACCREDITATION REGULATIONS

Please read the Regulations regarding the accreditation and safety and carefully fill in the Application Form for accreditation. Incorrect or incomplete accreditation forms may not be examined.

Basic Principles of Accreditation

By submitting the Accreditation Application, the journalist undertakes to duly and correctly inform the auditorium of the represented media on the event both before and after the event, as well as to use properly the official title of the competition.

By signing this accreditation I accept that all my visual materials could be used by the organiser free of charge, but must indicate me as an author of the visual material.

The accreditation is required for:

- journalists;
- media photographers;
- media video operators.

Only the persons having reached at least the age of 18 at the time of submission of the Accreditation Form shall be accredited.

Special Provisions for Photographers and Video Operators

All photographers and video operators willing to be accredited are required to have:

- Life Insurance Policy (including for sport competitions) ;

It is strictly prohibited to hand over the received media waistcoats to another persons.

The accredited photographers and video operators wearing media waistcoats have a right to be present in the areas of the track specially provided for photography and filming.

Safety Provisions for Media Representatives

1. The accredited photographers and video operators having received media waistcoats are entitled to be present only in the areas of the track indicated in the Safety Plan.
 2. The accredited journalists, photographers and video operators are obliged to observe all instructions given by track security personnel, clerks of the course and the officials of the competition.
 3. It is strictly prohibited to be under the influence of alcohol or narcotic substances in the territory of the event.
 4. The accredited journalists not wearing media waistcoats have no right to be in the track during the heats. The breach of this provision may result in the annulment of accreditation.
 5. Beware of moving vehicles and pay particular attention to the surrounding activities in the paddock and track! Your safety depends only on you.
 6. Avoid being too close to the racing cars in the paddock thus allowing the mechanics to work freely! Do not disturb work of a team!
 7. Avoid leaning against the racing cars, since they may start sudden movement. Do not touch car parts, for they may be fragile or hot!
 8. Avoid standing near to fire-fighting or ambulance cars. They may start sudden movement without prior warning.
 9. Choose the location in the track, which is as safe as possible! Be always prepared for non-standard situations or accidents in the track! If you are in the immediate vicinity of the track, constantly follow the on-going activities in the track.
 10. If it is necessary to review the taken photographic or video material, avoid doing it in the immediate vicinity of the track or during the heats. Choose a safer place or the premises of the Press Centre!
 11. Entering and leaving the track is allowed only through the press gate behind the starting grid and in between the heats. Follow the instructions of safety personnel! It is strictly prohibited to cross the track during the Heats.
 12. Presence in the pre-start area, as well as entering and leaving the track through the start gate during the event are not allowed. It is allowed to visit the premises of officials or VIP area only with the permission of the organizer.
- By receiving the accreditation you confirm that you have read the Safety Regulations and take full responsibility for your actions.**

COVID-19 CODE OF CONDUCT STAKEHOLDER COMMITMENT

Acknowledging the need for special measures in light of the COVID-19 pandemic, in consideration for being granted access to events that include competitions in FIA Championships, cups, trophies, challenges, series, and international series registered on the FIA international sporting calendar (**Covered Events**), the undersigned party (the **Stakeholder**) acknowledges and agrees as follows:

1. Subject only to clause 7 below, the Stakeholder agrees to be bound by and undertakes to comply in all respects with the COVID-19 Code of Conduct issued by the FIA (including as that Code may be amended from time to time) in respect of any and all employees, contractors, agents, representatives, consultants, and other individuals that the Stakeholders sends to a Covered Event for any purpose (each, an **Attendee**).
2. The Stakeholder undertakes only to send Attendees to Covered Events that:
 - 2.1. have been provided with copies of the COVID-19 Code and any amendments thereto;
 - 2.2. are Fit to Attend (as that term is defined in the COVID-19 Code of Conduct); and
 - 2.3. have signed a copy of the form attached as Schedule 1 hereto (the **Attendee Commitment**).
3. The Stakeholder acknowledges that the undertaking given at clause 2 above is a continuing one, and therefore each time it sends an Attendee to a Covered Event it is representing and undertaking that (a) that Attendee has been provided with a copy of the COVID-19 Code and has signed a copy of the Attendee Commitment; and (b) the Stakeholder has taken the steps required to satisfy itself that the Attendee remains Fit to Attend Covered Events.
4. To the extent that the Stakeholder contracts with any third parties for those third parties to send individuals to Covered Events, and such individuals will be Attendees of the Stakeholder, the Stakeholder will make such third parties aware of the COVID-19 Code of Conduct and the Stakeholder's obligations thereunder, and will ensure that any actions taken by the third parties are consistent with and enable the Stakeholder to comply with the COVID-19 Code of Conduct in all respects.
5. The Stakeholder will take appropriate measures to maintain the security of the health information collected from its Attendees (including Attendees falling within clause 4, above) and to comply with applicable laws relating to data protection and privacy.
6. If the Stakeholder has a contract with the FIA, it agrees that this Stakeholder Commitment

constitutes a valid and binding supplement to that contract, and that in case of conflict between that contract and this Stakeholder Commitment, this Stakeholder Commitment shall prevail.

7. As between the Stakeholder and the FIA, Article 4.5 of the Code of Conduct shall not apply. Instead, if there is currently a contract between the FIA and the Stakeholder that contains dispute resolution provisions (including governing law and jurisdiction provisions), those provisions will apply in the case of any dispute. If not, the following provisions shall apply in the case of any dispute:

7.1. This Stakeholder Commitment (including any claim or controversy arising out of or relating to it or to the COVID-19 Code of Conduct) shall be exclusively governed by, and construed in accordance with, French law, without regard to any conflict of law principles that could mandate the application of laws of another jurisdiction.

7.2. All disputes arising out of, or in connection with, this Stakeholder Commitment and/or the COVID-19 Code of Conduct shall be submitted to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Tribunal Judiciaire de Paris.

7.3. Where the COVID-19 Delegate decides for any reason that an Attendee of the Stakeholder should be ejected from and denied any further access to a Covered Event, that decision must be accepted and implemented immediately by the Stakeholder and the Attendee without challenge, save that any claim that such ejection and denial of access is a breach of rights for which compensation should be paid may be pursued in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this clause 7.

COVID-19 CODE OF CONDUCT ATTENDEE COMMITMENT

In consideration for being granted access to events that include competitions in FIA Championships, cups, trophies, challenges, series, and international series registered on the FIA international sporting calendar (**Covered Events**), I hereby acknowledge that I have read and understood the COVID-19 Code of Conduct issued by the FIA, and I agree to be bound by and undertake to comply with that Code of Conduct in all respects (including as it may be amended from time to time) for so long as I am attending or planning to attend Covered Events. In particular, I acknowledge and agree to Article 4.4 of the COVID-19 Code of Conduct, which reads:

4.4 While the protocols set out in this *COVID-19 Code* are designed to reduce the risk of transmission of the COVID-19 virus, each *Stakeholder* and each *Attendee* acknowledges that it is not possible to eliminate that risk entirely. Each *Attendee* assumes the risk of suffering an illness or fatality related to COVID-19 as a result of his/her participation in a *Covered Event*, and (in accordance with Article 1.1.3 of the International Sporting Code) agrees (on his/her own behalf, and on behalf of his/her estate, heirs, successors and assigns) that the *FIA* and its directors, officers, employees, agents, and officials shall bear no liability in respect of any such illness or fatality unless it is proven that the illness or fatality was suffered as a result of the *FIA's* willful misconduct or gross negligence. The *Attendee* will not bring any claim that is inconsistent with the foregoing sentence, and each *Stakeholder* agrees not to bring and will procure that its *Attendees* do not bring any claim that is inconsistent with the foregoing sentence.

As Organiser's Automobile sport club "Vilkyčiai" accredited person and traveling from or transit a country according to the current regulations of National Public Health Center under the Ministry of Health of Lithuania, I confirm that:

- 1) I have no signs of an acute respiratory infection;
- 2) I had done Covid-19 test no more than 72 h before arrival to Lithuania and I can provide a proof of a negative Covid-19 test to the race organiser;
- 3) Within 24 h after arrival in Lithuania I will take a Covid-19 test and I will provide the test result to the Organiser's medical personnel;
- 4) I will self-isolate at the residence/hotel in Lithuania/ parking, while waiting for the Covid-19 test result;
- 5) I will follow all Covid-19 restrictions that are in force in Lithuania, also follow this covid protocol and all Organiser's and promoter's guidelines;
- 6) Apart from taking part in the event and its related activities I will stay at the location (hotel/residence/team paddock) named in the form;
- 7) I will follow my own health condition, will measure my temperature at least twice a day and will inform the medical personnel in case of any symptoms of a fever or respiratory disease;
- 8) I will not use public transportation (only private transport or private transfers), I will not attend public events or venues (such as restaurants, bars and similar);
- 9) As much as possible - I will limit any contact with other persons during the stay in Lithuania.
- 10) I will cover all of the related costs of Covid-19 tests and, in case of a positive test result, the treatment.
