





Liability, Responsibilities, Rights And Duties Of Accredited Journalists

- 1. The Press Pass Is Not Transferable. It Remains The Property Of The Race Organizer Or Promoter, And Any Violation Of Safety And Organizational Rules, Such As Failure To Follow Instructions Given By The Organization Staff Will Lead To Immediate Withdrawal Of The Pass And Removal Of The Person From The Event. The Press Pass Must Include The Passholder's Name. The Vehicle License Plate Number Must Be Clearly Indicated On The Entrance Pass. Without This Data The Entrance Pass Will Be Immediately Withdrawn.
- 2. The Accredited Person May Use The Materials Obtained Within The Scope Of The Accreditation Only For Editorial Purposes. It Is Forbidden To Use These Materials For Commercial Purposes. If Such A Case Arises, The Person May Be Punished By Refusal To Grant Accreditation For The ASN Events For At Least One Year.
- 3. Accredited Journalists Must Strictly Observe All Motorsport Safety Rules And Follow All Instructions Given By Race Organizers And Marshals. Their Actions Must Not Jeopardize The Progress Of The Event, Their Own Or Anyone Else's Safety.
- 4. The Accredited Person And Every Entrance Pass Holder Acknowledge The Awareness That Motorsports Are Dangerous And That They Are Attending The Event At Their Own Risk. The Accredited Person Pledges That Neither Now Nor In The Future Will They Demand Compensation, Hold Liable, Accuse, Or Sue ASN, The Organizers, Promoters, National Sports Associations Or Clubs Involved In The Event, Nor Any Participating Team Or Driver, The Owner Of The Circuit, Or Other Organizations Participating In The Event, Including Directors, Individual Members, Marshals, Employees, Agents, Service Employees, Representatives, And Contractors In Case Of Personal Injury, Death, Or Loss Of Any Kind On The Part Of The Passholder In Connection With Their Presence At The Event.
- 5. The Accredited Person Undertakes Not To Cause Harm To ASN Or The Organizer And Will Not Claim From Them Or Their Agents Compensation For Any Damage Caused By A Third Party (Personal Injury, Death, Damage Or Loss Of Any Kind) Incurred During The Event.
- 6. Journalists / Photographers Have The Right To All Available Information Connected With The Running And Progress Of The Race (Race Results, Press Information, Etc.) That Are Available In The Press Centre Throughout The Course Of The Race.
- 7. If During The Accreditation Process The Applicant Ceases To Work For The Publisher Or Broadcaster, The Applicant Is Required To Inform The Organizer Of This Fact. They Will Then Automatically Be Required To Reapply For The Accreditation. Otherwise The Accreditation Cannot Be Granted To The Applicant.
- 8. The Applicant For Accreditation Is Required To Abide By All Hygienic And Cultural Rules Associated With Their Work And The Place Where They Will Carry It Out. They Agree Not To Restrict Their Colleagues, Other Journalists, Or Other People Employed At The Given Event With Their Behavior Or Actions.
